The Hornady® High Speed Power Case Trimmer brings three case preparation steps into one space saving tool. The powerful motor spins at 2000+ RPMs, allowing users to trim, chamfer, and deburr in one quick step. The trimmer features a click-adjustable micrometer for precise and consistent trimming. Compatible with cases from 22 cal up to 30 cal and lengths from 1.450" to 3.5".


GENERAL INFORMATION

Cartridge cases grow longer with repeated firing and reloading. When a case exceeds its maximum length, it can contact the throat of the firearm, preventing the bullet from releasing properly and increasing chamber pressure. Cases that exceed their maximum specified length should be trimmed to a length close to the minimum for that caliber. Refer to the Hornady Handbook of Cartridge Reloading for case trim specifications and other case prep information.

- Familiarize yourself with the trimmer by studying these instructions.
- Use caution around moving parts and sharp tools.

- Do not use this product on or near damp surfaces.
- Plug power cord into a properly grounded outlet.
- Wear eye protection.
- Take your time and do not attempt to bypass instructions.






SET UP INTRUCTIONS

Secure the trimmer to your bench with two 1/2" diameter bolts, nuts and washers. Select a bolt length based on the dimensions of your bench.

A. Insert the correct pilot for caliber into the cutter housing and tighten the pilot screw with 5/64" hex wrench. (For instance, use trimmer Pilot 22 for .223 Remington.)



B. Ensure cutter blades are bottomed out on pilot shoulder and tightened with hex wrench.



C. Insert cutter housing onto motor shaft and tighten set screw with hex wrench. Make sure cutter housing is bottomed out on motor shaft.





- D. Attach clear protective cover to motor faceplate using brass thumb screws and slide shaving tray under the cover to catch trimmings.
- E. Select a case-rim-specific collet using the tables below:

- F. Turn the collet housing cap clockwise (opposite of normal) to unscrew. Insert collet and tighten cap. Do NOT tighten the handle WITHOUT a case in the collet because this could result in a hent collet.
- G. OPTIONAL: Attach bin mounting bracket to baseplate with #10-24 bolts and slide case catch bin onto mount.









TRIMMING PROCEDURE


 With the motor off, loosen thumb screws on adjustable hard stop and push macro-adjust hard stop all the way toward face of trimmer.



 Align rim of case to be trimmed into mouth of collet and rotate handle clockwise to close. Case should be snug and concentric to pilot.



 With the motor off, slowly move shuttle until case mouth touches pilot and cutters. Pushing too hard can damage case mouth.



 Move adjustable hard stop until it makes contact with shuttle and tighten thumb screws on detent portions of slide rods.



 Rotate micro adjust dial until case mouth is just off cutter blades when bottomed out on hard stop.



6. After completing step 5, return shuttle back to end of rods.



7. Plug in trimmer and turn on motor with on/off switch.



 Slowly push shuttle forward until micro adjust screw bottoms out on adjustable hard stop.



9. Slowly turn micro adjust dial clockwise to move case toward cutter blades.


Micro-adjust dial allows for click-adjust increments of .001".



 When case mouth is trimmed, return shuttle to back of slide rods and turn trimmer off.



 Remove case from collet and measure overall length with calipers.
 Consult Hornady Handbook of Cartridge Reloading for ideal case length according to SAAMI specifications. (Handbook sold separately).



 Subtract ideal case length from measured case length and turn micro adjust dial clockwise the correct number of clicks in .001" increments.

For example: Measured case length = 1.480" Ideal case length = 1.475" 1.480 - 1.475 = .005" .005" = 5 clicks on micro adjust dial





13. Reinstall case into collet and tighten thumb screw on back of micro adjust housing.



 Turn on motor and slowly bring case mouth onto pilot. Case shavings will begin to fall into tray below.



 Once shavings stop coming off case, return shuttle to back of rods, turn off trimmer and remove case for measurement.



16. Use calipers to measure case. If adjustments are needed, loosen thumb screw on micro adjust housing and adjust dial accordingly.



17. After attaining ideal case length, begin bulk trimming. Make sure each case sits flat on collet and check trimmed cases for length frequently.
