

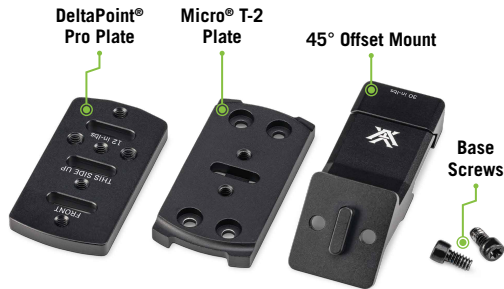

Red Dot Mounting

To get the best results from your red dot, proper mounting is essential. Although not difficult, the correct steps must be followed.

Mounting Checklist

- Gun vise or a solid platform for your rifle
- Pro 45° Offset Accessory Picatinny Mount
- Torque wrench

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

CAUTION: Ensure firearm is unloaded before making any modifications.

CAUTION: Ensure all screws are securely tightened to the recommended torque before shooting.

Note: All torque specs are given as inch pounds (in-lbs) not foot pounds.

Mounting

1. Loosen the two base screws.
2. Install the assembly onto a Weaver® or Picatinny base.
3. Individually tighten the base screws while pressing the mount down and forward, towards the muzzle, ensuring it is seated against a cross-slot in the rail. Tighten the two base screws to 30 in-lbs.

Red Dot Mounting

1. Your 45° Offset Mount comes assembled with a DeltaPoint® Pro Plate, if this plate works with your red dot, you can move on to the steps below. But, if you need to change out the plate, simply remove the two plate mounting screws and attach your desired plate.
2. Place the red dot on top of your plate, being careful to match up the screw holes and recoil lugs. Ensure that the red dot sits flush on the mount.
3. Using the DeltaPoint® Pro Plate, select the M4x11mm screws. Using the Micro® T-2 Plate, select the standard screws. Both sets of screws are included with your red dot.
4. Tighten down the screws following your red dot manual to ensure proper torque.
